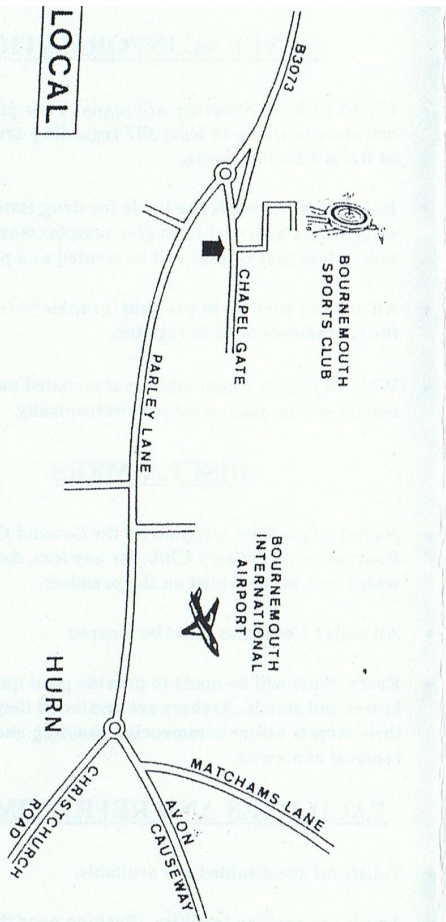
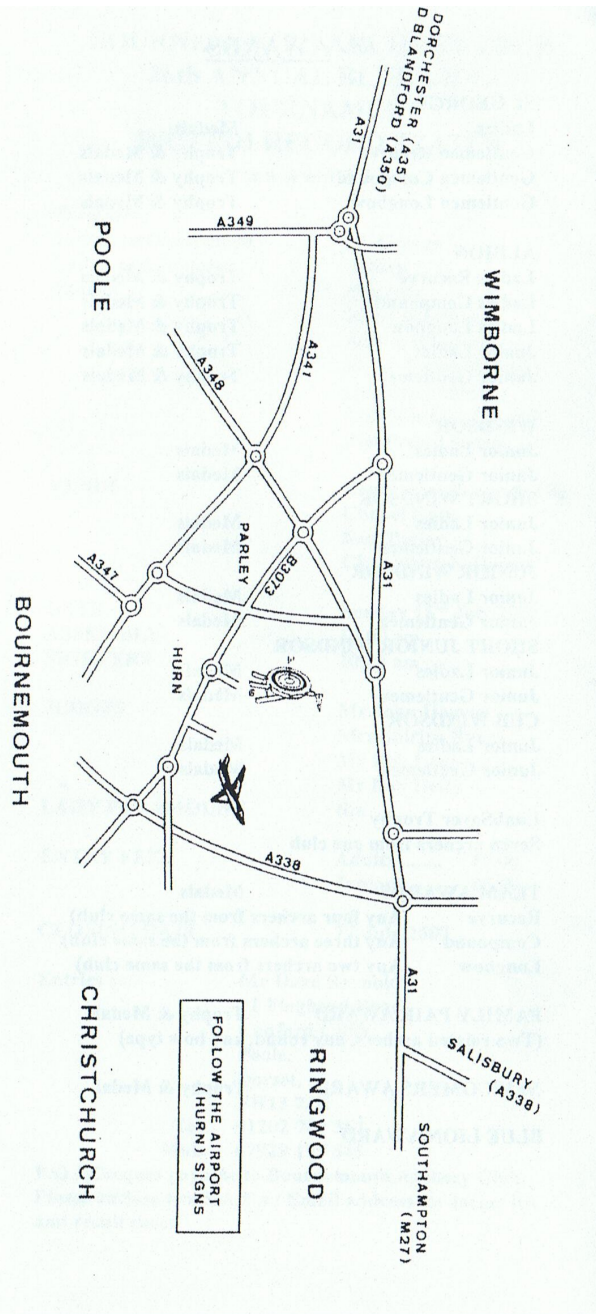

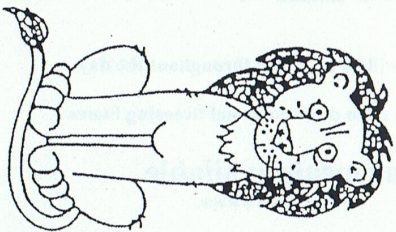

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

- GNAS Rules of Shooting will apply. Your particular attention is drawn to Rule 307 regarding dress regulations at Record Status shoots.
- 4 target spaces are reserved for disabled archers. The spaces will be allocated on a first come first served basis and will be released to any archer if they have not been taken up by the closing date.
- Use of total carbon arrows or fibreglass arrows is not permitted due to the venue being a sports ground.
- Record Status shoots are liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.
- Record Status shoots are subject to equipment checks prior to the start of the shoot.
- Arrows will be shot in timed ends – 6 arrows in 4 mins
- All archers wishing to use photographic/video equipment at the tournament need to register.

**DISCLAIMERS**

- No liability will be accepted by the Ground Owners or Bournemouth Archery Club, for any loss, damage or injury which may occur whilst on the premises.
- All tents/umbrellas must be secured.
- Every effort will be made to provide good quality secure bosses and stands. Archers are reminded they should check their targets before commencing shooting and after removal of arrows.

**FACILITIES AND REFRESHMENTS**

- Toilets for the disabled are available.
- Ample car parking facilities.
- We regret that dogs will not be permitted anywhere on the grounds.
- Light refreshments will be available throughout the day.
- The bar may be open during normal licensing hours.
