

Equipment List

Apart from your bow and arrows, you will need other equipment to complete your archery kit. We have put together a list of necessary and useful equipment to help you get set up!

1 – Shooting Equipment (Necessary)

Bow Bag & Stand
Bow Stringer & two strings
Sight
Pressure Button
Arrow Rest
Long Rod (stabilization)
Quiver
Tab / Release aid
Arm Brace
Chest Guard
Bow Sling
Spare Nocks, Fletchings & Points
Brace Height Gauge

2 – Comfort Items

Chair
Umbrella / Tent / Windbreak
Mallet / Hammer, Pegs
Food and drink
Jumper / Jacket
Sunglasses
Hat

3 – Weather protection

Waterproof Trousers
Waterproof Jacket
Weather Boots / Wellingtons
Towel

1 – Shooting Equipment (Useful)

Score Pad and Pen(s)
Repair kit box
Fletching Jig
Fletching Glue
Dental Floss/Serving String
Knife
Spare Decals
String Wax
Cliniband
Foot Markers

4 – Useful Others

Insect Repellent
Sun Block
Small change / Cash
Umbrella (Hand)
Binoculars / Scope and Stand

This list is only a guide, add to the list as necessary and watch it grow.

You should check your equipment ideally the night before any competition or before starting practice. Here is a basic checklist:

Riser is undamaged
Limbs are undamaged
String is undamaged and waxed
Sight is undamaged
Arrows are marked with number and initials
Fletchings are secure and in good condition
Points and nocks are undamaged / secure
Pressure button is clean and moves freely
Sight mounting is secure
Tab and bow / finger slings are undamaged
